

Professor Dr Theodoros Xanthos



Theodoros Xanthos was born in Athens. He has finished medicine in the National and Capodistrian University of Athens and he has specialized in Internal Medicine and Cardiology in Athens and London UK. He holds an MSc Degree on Clinical Toxicology (University of Cardiff) and an MRes on Education (University of Liverpool). He also holds a Doctorate degree from Athens. He is a Fellow of the Higher Education Academy, a Fellow of the Academy of Medical Educators, a Fellow of the European Resuscitation Council (ERC), a Fellow of the American College of Pharmacology and he is also a Fellow of the European

Society of Cardiology. Moreover, he is the only European Certified Toxicologist in Cyprus. He is a Professor of Resuscitation for the University of Cagliari and a Professor of Pharmacology for Midwestern University of Chicago. He is an ERC Medical Educator for Europe. He has an impact factor of 700, an h-index of 25 and his total number of citations are more than 3000. He is currently a Professor of Medicine for European University Cyprus.
