

Dr Konstantinides is Professor for Clinical Trials and Deputy Scientific Director of the multidisciplinary Centre for Thrombosis and Haemostasis (CTH) at the University of Mainz, Germany. The CTH is dedicated to patient care and translational research and is funded by the federal German government. Dr Konstantinides is also Professor of Cardiology at the Democritus University of Thrace, Greece. He graduated from Medical School of the Aristotle University, Thessalonica, Greece. He then completed his clinical training in Cardiology and defended his thesis at the University of Freiburg Germany. He has worked as consultant cardiologist at the Universities of Freiburg and Goettingen, Germany, and as a research associate at the Department of Vascular Biology, the Scripps

Research Intitute, La Jolla, CA, USA. His research focuses on basic mechanisms of thrombosis and on the risk stratification and antithrombotic management of venous thromboembolism. He has published over 150 papers in peer-reviewed journals and more than 20 book chapters. He has designed and coordinated, as principal investigator, several national and international multicenter trials. His research is being supported by national and European peer reviewed granting agencies. Dr. Konstantinides is currently heading the European Society of Cardiology (ESC) task force for the update of the Guidelines on the Management of Acute Pulmonary Embolism.
