

Athanasios J. Manolis, MD, PhD



Professor Athanasios J. Manolis graduated from the Athens University, Medical School in 1979. At present he is the Director of the Cardiology Department of the Asklepeion Hospital, Athens, Greece. Moreover, he has a position as Adj. Professor of Medicine, Emory University, Atlanta, USA and Adj. Ass. Professor of Hypertension, Boston University, Boston, USA. Athanasios J. Manolis is Past-President and General Secretary of the Mediterranean Association of Cardiology and Cardiac Surgery, ex-member of the Council of the European Society of Hypertension, past Chairperson of the Working Group “Hypertension and Heart” of the European Society of Cardiology, and President

of the Working Group “Hypertension Arrhythmias and Thrombosis” of the ESH. He is Past President of the Hellenic Society of Hypertension, and was President of the Joint Meetings of ESH/ISH 2014 in Athens. Dr Athanasios J. Manolis is member of the editorial Board and reviewer of several journals in the field of Hypertension and Cardiology. He has been involved as member of the steering committee or principal investigator in more than 100 multicenter trials in the field of hypertension, coronary heart disease, heart failure atrial fibrillation and genetics. He published more than 200 papers in peer-reviewed international journals about several aspects of hypertension, heart failure, coronary heart disease, preventive cardiology and genetics, and more than 50 chapters in books.

Professor Athanasios J. Manolis is member of the American College of Cardiology, the American Heart Association, the Hypertension Council of the American Heart Association, the European Society of Hypertension, the International Society of Hypertension, the Mediterranean Association of Cardiology and Cardiac Surgery. His special areas of interest and expertise are in all aspects of hypertension, coronary heart disease, neurohormonal activation and treatment of heart failure, and atrial fibrillation.
