Facilitation approach

Nina Sønderberg (Nordic Wellbeing Academy / European Health Futures Forum; member, WHO/Europe Public Health Innovation Platform) will lead this session. Nina has extensive experience in co-design processes, futures facilitation, and creative knowledge translation. She will guide groups through:

- A brief provocation - three possible worlds of 2050, presented as vivid narrative sketches (hopeful, cautionary, and wild-card)
- Small group formation - deliberately cross-disciplinary and cross-cultural
- Facilitated scenario building - each group selects or invents their future and begins mapping its key features: what do systems, communities, relationships, and daily life look like?
- Visual poster creation - groups translate their scenario into a large-format visual poster, combining text, image, and metaphor
- Gallery walk and sharing - posters are displayed; groups briefly present their future world; cross-pollination and reflection

Output

A set of 5–8 scenario posters produced by participants — bridging disciplines and perspectives. These will be photographed, digitised, and shared as a visual output of the day
